



Mr/Ms/MsTer/Miss Bay Area Rodeo 2010 Title Holder Requirements

Individuals holding the title of Mr., Ms., MsTer, or Miss Bay Area Rodeo 2009 will be expected to fulfill the following duties during their title year. The title year will begin upon award of the title during the crowning ceremony and will conclude at the step-down ceremony in the following year. Failure to fulfill these duties will require the forfeiture of the title and immediate return of all awards received in conjunction with the title (e.g., sash, buckle, crown).

In the event that a title is forfeited during the title year, the 1st Runner Up in that division (if any) will step-up to fill the position and will be expected to fulfill these duties to the best of their ability.

- Participate with GSGRA Bay Area Chapter in 2010 Pride Festivals in San Francisco and San Jose.
- Attend a minimum of 3 GSGRA Bay Area Chapter meetings.
- Actively participate in the efforts of the Bay Area Chapter's Fundraising and Community Outreach.
- Participate on the Outreach Committee.
- Individually raise a minimum of \$1,500 over the course of the year for the GSGRA Bay Area Chapter and Best Buck in the Bay Rodeo (combined total for both BAC and BBitB). While the individual goal is \$1,500, keep in mind that the total Royalty Team fundraising goal is \$6,000.
- Try to attend our other GSGRA rodeos in Palm Springs (April 30-May 2, 2010) and San Diego (September 10-12, 2010). In addition to the GSGRA rodeos, try to attend at least two non-GSGRA Rodeos prior to step-down in 2011.
- Promote and help recruit new contestants for the subsequent year's Royalty Contest.
- Attend the step-down/crowning ceremony at the following year's royalty competition.
- Remain a member in good standing of GSGRA affiliated with the Bay Area Chapter.
